Key Responsibilities

- 1. Correspond with companies interested in performing at the venue for the 2018 Festival, late night programme.
- 2. Select companies to perform at Bedlam Theatre in the 2018 Festival, late night programme.
- 3. Be responsible for negotiating the necessary financial agreements and working in conjunction with the Programming Director for generating applicable hire contracts for performing companies.
- 4. Read all applications to perform at the venue in their entirety and discuss their content with the other members of the programming team.
- 5. Manage the programming assistants in conjunction with the Programming Director.
- 6. Collaborate with the programming team to produce all promotional materials distributed to interested companies throughout the course of the programming process.
- 7. Develop and articulate the programme vision for Late Night Fringe 2018 for the benefit of the Venue team and the companies selected to perform.
- 8. Meet and liaise with the Edinburgh Festival Fringe Office to ensure that registration and promotion of the programmed shows proceeds smoothly.
- 9. Be present for at least part of the 2018 Edinburgh Fringe Festival to liase with performers, ensure the smooth running of the Late Night cabaret and preview companies and productions which may become a part of the 2019 Bedlam Fringe programme.

Key Relationships

- 1. The Director of Late Night is accountable to EUSA in the first instance. They will have contact with key staff members regarding financial and HR matters.
- Key contacts with EUSA will be: Director of Finance and the HR Department.
- 3. There may be reasonable changes to duties, compensation and responsibilities of the Director of Late Night from time to time which will be outlined by EUSA.
- 4. In order to undertake the duties required of the role, the Director of Late Night will be expected to be present at the Bedlam Theatre on a part time basis from the date of appointment until the end of May. The Director of Late Night will receive an honorarium payment in recognition of their activities.

- 1. Understanding of different types of comedy and the aspects that go into making it.
- 2. A very positive attitude towards Bedlam and a strong desire to work for us and to help support future developments to reach consistent standards of excellence.
- 3. A dedication to delivering a genuinely world class festival programme.

- 5. Ability to plan and prioritise with attention to detail.

- 7. Ability to integrate and operate well in a team environment.
